<i>Borage</i>	Borage officinalis	bluish-lavender	cucumber-like
<i>Calendula</i>	Calendula officinalis	orange, yellow	spicy, tangy, peppery
<i>Carnation</i>	Dianthus spp.	pink, red, lavender	spicy, peppery, clove-like
<i>Chive</i>	Allium spp.	lavender	onion-like
<i>Chrysanthemum</i>	Chrysanthemum spp.	yellow, white	slightly to very bitter
<i>Cornflower</i>	Centaurea cyanus	blue, pink	sweet to spicy, clove-like
<i>Daisy, English</i>	Bellis perennis	white, pastels	tangy, leafy
<i>Day Lily (Lily Buds)</i>	Hemerocallis spp.	yellow, orange, red	sweet, crunchy
<i>Dianthus (pinks)</i>	Dianthus spp.	pink, many colors	clove-like
<i>Fennel</i>	Foeniculum vulgare	yellow	sweet, licorice
<i>Fuschia</i>	Fuschia X hybrida	bi-colors, varied	acidic
<i>Garlic Chive</i>	Allium	white, pink	garlic-like
<i>Geranium</i>	Pelargonium spp.	pink, red, white, peach	varies by breed
<i>Hollyhock</i>	Althaea rosea	pink, white, lavender, red	bland
<i>Impatiens</i>	Impatiens wallerana	pink, many colors	bland
<i>Johnny-jump-ups</i>	Viola tricolor	purple, white, yellow, bi-	sweet to bland
<i>Lavender</i>	Lavandula angustifolia	purple	floral
<i>Lilac</i>	Syringa vulgaris	lavender	lemony, floral, pungent
<i>Mallow, malva</i>	Malva spp.	purple, pink, white	delicate, sweet
<i>Marigold</i>	Tagetes spp.	orange, yellow	spicy to bitter
<i>Nasturtium</i>	Tropaeolum majus	red, orange, yellow	peppery
<i>Orchids</i>		purple/white	crisp, warm and soft
<i>Pansy</i>	Viola X Wittrockiana	purple, white, yellow, bi-	sweet to tart
<i>Parrot-beak</i>	Clianthus puniceus	yellow, red, bi-colors	crisp, leafy
<i>Petunia</i>	Petunia X hybrida	many colors	leafy
<i>Pineapple Sage</i>	Salvia elegans	red	sweet, pineapple
<i>Primrose</i>	Primula vulgaris	many colors	sweet to bland
<i>Rose</i>	Rosa spp.	many colors	sweet, aromatic
<i>Rosemary</i>	Rosemarinus officinalis	light blue	sweet, pine-like
<i>Sage</i>	Salvia officinalis	many colors	varies by breed
<i>Scarlet Runner Beans</i>	Phaseolus coccineus	scarlet	nectar, bean-like
<i>Snapdragon</i>	Antirrhinum majus	pink, yellow, white, bi-col	bland to bitter
<i>Squash Blossom</i>	Cucurbita spp.	yellow	nectar, sweet
<i>Stock</i>	Matthiola spp.	purple, white, pink, yell	spicy to sweet, aromatic

<i>Sunflower</i>	<i>Helianthus annuus</i>	gold, yellow	leafy
<i>Tansy</i>	<i>Tanacetum vulgare</i>	rust, gold	bitter
<i>Thyme</i>	<i>Thymus vulgaris</i>	white, purple	lemony
<i>Tulip</i>	<i>Tulipa</i> spp.	many colors	crisp, cucumber-like
